

Bridgnorth Cricket Club Transportation and Changing Policy

Transportation to Matches and Practice Sessions.

Bridgnorth Cricket Clubs (BCC) policy is that parents/legal guardians or other responsible adults are responsible for transporting players to and from all matches and practice sessions.

The Club (BCC) will not be registering private vehicles for the transportation of individuals in connection with any fixtures or practice sessions arranged by the Club (BCC).

The implementation of this policy is not intended to exclude any player from participation and parents/legal guardians should contact the aged group Manager if they have any problems with the transportation of players to matches or practice sessions.

Changing Policy.

For players under the age of 16 years, playing in Club (BCC) representative teams the following policy applies.

- Young players uncomfortable with changing with adults are under no obligation to do so and are advised to change at home when attending training sessions.
- The players are expected to wear appropriate clothing when representing the Club (BCC) on match days.
- Parental consent must be given if young players are to share changing facilities with adults.
- If young players are sharing changing rooms with adults, parents have the option to supervise them when changing. The Club (BCC) will make reasonable efforts to arrange this.

Consent by Parent/Legal Guardian.
